A COSTA RICAN LONG-DISTANCE RUNNER

Gabriela Traña Trigueros, a Costa Rican long-distance runner, was born on March 3 1980 in Alajuela. She started her career when she was 13 years old. Her first experiences were at Gregorio José Ramírez High School, where she was under the guidance of her teacher Juan Carlos Vega González, who is currently her trainer.



In addition, when she was 14, she obtained her first two gold medals at the "Juegos Deportivos Nacionales" in Santa Cruz, Guanacaste. She has participated in several competitions; for example, in marathons at the Central American Games, the Pan-American Games and the Ibero-American Games, at the Olympic Games in Beijing and in London. At the Summer Olympics 2012, Traña not only participated at the games, but she was also the flag bearer for the Costa Rican team during the opening ceremony.

Some Gabriela's achievements are a gold medal in Ciudad Panama in 10,000 mts, a gold medal at the San José Marathon in 2013, and at the Central American Games 2004. She also got two golden medals in 1500 mts and 10,000 mts in Nicaragua. Furthermore, she practices swimming as a hobby. Gabriela Traña also studied to receive a university degree. She is now a nutritionist.

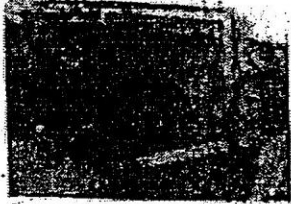

TRADITIONAL CUISINE

The main basis around Costa Rican dishes is its native ingredients. The locals do a great job of combining the national flavors to make a delicious menu. Breakfast is similar to the dishes served in the United States with a few Costa Rican changes. For example, eggs, bacon and sausages are found almost everywhere. It is not unusual to eat simply a bowl of cereal or fruit salad to start the day. People also eat *Gallo pinto* which is fried rice and beans served with *Lizano* sauce. Often a corn tortilla is served with this delicious combination of rice and beans.



For lunch and dinner, Costa Ricans eat very similar dishes. Most Ticos usually eat a *casado* as a main dish at lunch time. The side dishes are rice, beans, chicken, fish, beef or pork, stew, salad and fried plantains. *Arroz con pollo* is very popular, too. It is a simple dish with each chef having a slightly different approach to cooking it. One must not forget the Caribbean coast, which certainly has its own unique cuisine, making it distinctive from the rest of the nation. As with many other Caribbean destinations, the dishes have a Jamaican influence with spices, curries and other ingredients. Finally, coffee is probably the most consumed and the most popular Costa Rican beverage.

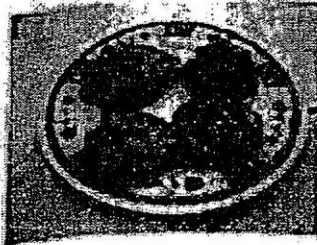

PATACONES

INGREDIENTS:

- 2 green plantains
- 1 cup vegetable oil
- 1 pinch salt, to taste



DIRECTIONS:

- First, completely peel the plantains and slice them into small rounds.
- Second, heat oil in a saucepan until it almost boils to place the plantain rounds in it.
- Then, leave the plantain rounds in the hot oil for about two minutes until they get light brown.
- Next, carefully remove the plantain rounds with a slotted spoon, and place them on a cutting board.
- The following step is to cover the plantain rounds with parchment paper and press firmly to flatten them.
- Then, place the flat pieces of plantain rounds in the oil again until they get golden brown.
- Finally, once the *patacones* are ready, sprinkle them with salt to taste.

As a matter of fact, people may eat *patacones* by dipping them in warm refried beans or having them with *ceviche*.

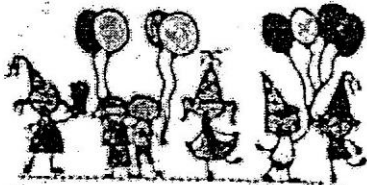

THE SEARCH FOR COSTA RICA'S GOLDEN TOAD



Recently, a group of biologists embarked on a mission to rediscover one of Costa Rica's most beloved animals, the golden toad which was officially declared extinct in 2004. The once abundant toads died off in droves in the late 1980s. Biologists have never conclusively determined the cause of the mass deaths, but temperature has increased and an amphibian fungus is still the suspected killer.

Many of the frogs and toads declared extinct in the 80's and 90's were later rediscovered, giving biologists hope for the future. Now, the Herpetological Exploration and Research Team H.E.A.R.T. which is a group of North American and Mexican biologists think it's the golden toad's turn to return to the public interest

Recently, H.E.A.R.T. launched a crowd funding campaign on *Kickstarter* (a funding platform for creative projects) with the goal of raising \$15,000 for the expedition. If the project gets funded, the group will send five team members to Costa Rica to search for living specimens. Finding the amphibian will be difficult not only because it may be extinct, but also because of its explosive breeding habits. Golden toads only come above ground to mate for nine to twelve days a year, usually after the second or third strong rains of the year. H.E.A.R.T. will arrive in Monteverde during the toad's last known breeding ground, in March. There, the team will wait until the rains come.

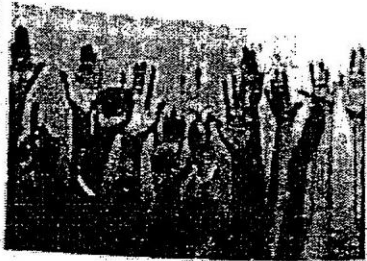

THE DEMOCRATIC HISTORY OF A COUNTRY



Costa Rica has enjoyed peaceful democratic elections and pacific transitions of power. This stability of the government has benefited Costa Ricans in many ways. In addition, although Costa Ricans have enjoyed the benefits of political stability and peace, there were some periods of violence in the last hundred years.

For example, in 1948, José Figueres Ferrer led a disputed presidential election and an armed uprising. This led to 2000 deaths and a forty-four day Costa Rican Civil War which was the most uncontrollable event in Costa Rica in the twentieth century. As a result, this event led the victorious government to abolish the military in 1949. The new government also drafted a new constitution by a democratically-elected assembly. In fact, the new Costa Rican government established by the assembly held their first democratic election under the new constitution in 1953, when they elected José Figueres Ferrer as a President.

Costa Rica has consistently been among the top Latin American countries in the Human Development Index. In addition, Costa Rica ranks first in the Americas in terms of Environmental Performance Index and the Costa Rican government announced plans for Costa Rica to become the first carbon neutral country by 2021.

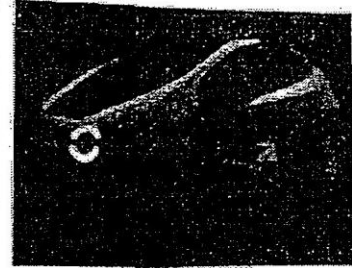

A SELF-DRIVING CAR

A self-driving car is a vehicle that is capable of fulfilling the human transportation necessities the way traditional cars do. By detecting its environment and navigating without human input, this type of car uses techniques such as radar, GPS, and computer vision. In fact, the advanced control systems help this vehicle sense its surroundings and interpret sensory information to identify appropriate navigation paths, as well as obstacles and relevant signage.



In addition, self-driving cars avoid traffic collisions, increase roadway capacity, reduce traffic congestion, as well as the improvement of parking because they could park far away where space is not scarce, and return as needed to pick up passengers, among other advantages. However, these vehicles present certain disadvantages such as low software reliability, the implementation of a legal framework, and the establishment of government regulations for self-driving cars. Another disadvantage is that climatic conditions like snow do not allow lane markings to become visible, diminishing self-driving cars' abilities.

Recently, significant advances have been made in both technology and legislation fields which are relevant to self-driving cars. In January 2014, Inrupt Technology's Navia shuttle became the first self-driving vehicle to be available for commercial sale. In fact, the open-air electric vehicle resembles a golf cart and seats up to eight people.

A WAY OF LIVING

Costa Ricans, as people in other countries, are caught between old cultural forces and new ones that influence especially its young population. Most Ticos still respect traditional values, but they're starting to adopt several North American cultural behavior learned on social networks.



Ticos are pretty homogeneous racially and culturally speaking, since only 1% of their population is considered to be Aboriginal, and the other Black and Chinese minorities aren't very numerous. Ticos also have a very high level of education and the literacy rate is 96%.

Costa Rican adults are still conservative with respect to family issues. Traditions revolve around the family from the moment of birth to that of death. HOMELESSNESS



Homelessness describes those people without a regular address of residence. Homeless people are often unable to acquire and maintain regular, secure, and adequate housing. These people usually have a vehicle, cardboard boxes, a tent or a park bench as a night-time residence.

Most countries provide a variety of services to assist homeless people. They often provide food, shelter, and clothing. They may be organized and run by community organizations, government departments, charities, churches or individual donors. Major reasons and causes for homelessness include unavailability of employment opportunities, poverty and disability among others.

THE INVENTION OF GOOGLE



Google is the most popular Internet search engine in the world. It was invented by two students, Larry Page and Sergey Brin. They met in 1995, when they were both studying computer science at Stanford University. They were also fans of the science fiction program Star Trek, and they loved the spaceship computer.

They dreamed of producing something that could also answer any questions in seconds due to Internet search engines were slow and gave many websites that weren't useful. In January 1996, Page and Brin decided to make a better and faster browser. Nobody would give them money for their project, so they used their credit cards and bought as much computer memory as possible. They also borrowed money from family and friends.

Then, in 1998, they were given a check for \$100,000 and they started their own company. Their first office was in a friend's garage. The Google search engine was soon used by thousands of people worldwide because it was fast, easy and accurate. By 2002, it was the biggest search engine on the Internet. Now, more questions are answered by Google than any other Internet service, from sports to science, and from music to medicine, and so on.
